TVIs at DGCKids provide early intervention services to infants and toddlers who are blind or visually impaired and their families.

The service model is family-centered and involves a holistic, multi-disciplinary team approach to bring critical resources to children, their families and caregivers, during the crucial early years of their development.



Primary TVI Responsibilities

- Conducts functional vision and developmental assessments
- Plans, develops and implements individualized services
- Works closely with parents and team members to assure high quality and coordinated service delivery
- Supports parents and other professionals in understanding the child's visual impairment and its effect on the child's development
- Stays current on best practices
